# QUALITY OF THE OCCURRENCE REPORTS SUBMITTED TO THE DCA

#### 1. General Information:

The Department of Civil Aviation operates a system for collecting occurrence reports in accordance with Cyprus Regulation 334/2005. The quality of the content of these reports is often poor and requires improvement.

## 2. Improvement of the Quality of the Reports:

The originators of the reports are requested to note the following points when preparing a report:

- 1. Every effort should be made so that hand written reports are clearly legible.
- 2. Originators should avoid reporting events that are not relevant to the safety of an aircraft, its occupants or any other person.
- 3. Depending on the nature of the incident, basic information (for example locations, aircraft type, date etc.) should be included in the report.
- 4. The content of the report should be as brief and to the point as possible.
- 5. Only events that have actually occurred should be reported. If the originator is not sure that an event has occurred he should not include this information in the report.
- 6. The reporting system is not intended to be used as a platform for raising personal or union issues.
- 7. Abbreviations of words and acronyms of technical terms should be avoided where practicable.
